



The University of Barcelona

Since it was founded in the Late Middle Ages, in the year 1450, the University of Barcelona has always played an important role in providing academic and scientific services to the community. A point of historical reference for Catalan society, the University has witnessed the various changes and events that have marked Barcelona's history and the history of Catalonia and Spain, and it stands today as one of the country's most prestigious institutions for research and higher education.

A city university with close historical ties to Barcelona, the UB's six campuses are all located within the inner city, hereby fostering the mutually beneficial relationship that city and university must have. The UB's campuses are the Diagonal Campus and Gateway to Knowledge, the Mundet-UB Campus, the Humanities Campus, the Medicine Campus and the Hospital Clinic August Pi Sunyer, the Bellvitge Health Sciences Campus and, finally, the future Torribera Food and Nutrition Campus.

In its twenty centres, the University offers the widest range of subjects of all the Catalan institutions of higher education to more than eighty thousand undergraduate and postgraduate students studying on campus or online. Following European Higher Education Area directives, for the academic year 2007-2008 the UB has also launched a total of eighty-eight official master's degree programs.

With regard to research, the UB is one of the most active universities at a national level and has been ranked amongst the most important university institutions worldwide. It is the one Catalan university that comes within the two hundred universities considered to offer the highest level of academic quality worldwide and amongst the one hundred universities in this same category within Europe; the work of its researchers can also be read in the scientific community's most prestigious international publications.

Strengthening its ties with the community and reinforcing its presence there, the UB works hand in hand with the association of foundations and institutions known as the UB Group. The UB group's collective purpose is to promote the University's activities and results in different academic and professional fields, and its principle institutions are the Bosch i Gimpera Foundation (FBG), the Barcelona Science Park Foundation (PCB) and the UB's Institute for Lifelong Learning (IL3-UB).

The information in the following pages is designed to summarise the broad-ranging activities of the University of Barcelona during recent years. But while the figures, tables and lists may constitute a fair reflection of its achievements at a glance, it is the

diversity and excellence of the UB's members which has made the University of Barcelona what if is today.




